



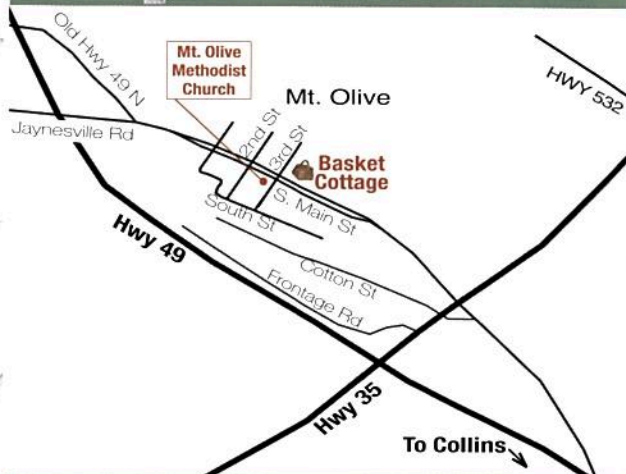
The baskets are dyed with local nut shells. Marilyn boils the shells several hours in a big black kettle. Then she strains the shells out. When the dye is boiling again, Marilyn usually dips the whole basket into the dye. Choose from pecan, black walnut or leave it natural.

DIRECTIONS:

From Jackson take Highway 49 South to Mount Olive. Take Jaynesville Road from 49. It turns into Main Street and go past the Methodist Church. The Basket Cottage will be on the left.



From Hattiesburg take Highway 49 North to Mt. Olive. Take Highway 35 East to S. Main Street (The third street to the left). Go into downtown Mt. Olive and the Basket Cottage will be on the right past the Post Office.

Parking is located on the side of the Basket Cottage on Third Street.

HISTORY

Marilyn Diehl's nephew, Roger Jamison, began weaving when he was 13. By the time he was 18 in 1994, he was accepted into the Craftsmen's Guild of Mississippi, Inc. Also a teacher, Marilyn began watching Roger and learning to make baskets. Helping Roger for a year or two, Marilyn had no idea that in 2002 she would buy his business and move his 500-square-foot shop to the Diehl family home nestled on Highway 532 near Hot Coffee, MS. In the fall of 2015, Marilyn moved the business to its current location on Main Street in Mount Olive and changed the name to the Basket Cottage.

MATERIALS

Split rattan is used to

make the baskets. Solid hickory and oak are used for the handles. The baskets are trimmed with seagrasses, round reed and cane. Each basket is dated, numbered and signed.

SUCCESS

Marilyn's baskets have been shipped all over the United States and Canada as well as Italy, Germany, Brazil and England. Roger's Basketry has also been featured in Southern Living, Mississippi Farm Country, Our South and Oak Street magazines.
